

EQUINE PURCHASE CONSULTING AGREEMENT

1. SERVICES PROVIDED

Consultant agrees to assist Client in locating, evaluating, test riding, hauling, and/or consulting on the purchase of a horse or mule suitable for the Client's intended use and needs.

Consultant may provide:

- Horse locating services
- Horse evaluations
- Test rides
- Suitability assessments
- Trial/evaluation periods
- Transportation coordination
- General consultation regarding equine purchases

2. CONSULTING FEE

Client agrees to pay Consultant a consulting fee equal to **10% of the purchase price** of the horse or mule purchased through Consultant's services.

This fee is due immediately upon purchase of the horse/mule.

3. HAULING FEES

Any hauling performed by consultant will be charged at:

\$3.50 per loaded mile

EQUINE PURCHASE CONSULTING AGREEMENT

Mileage will include trips related to:

- Horse pickup
- Delivery
- Evaluations
- Trial periods
- Transportation to Client (only available within 200 miles of Melrose, MT)

4. OPTIONAL 30-DAY EVALUATION PROGRAM

Client may elect to have Consultant keep and evaluate the horse for a 30-day period prior to final placement or transfer to Client.

Evaluation Fee:

\$1,500 per month

During this time, Consultant will (see assessment sheet):

- Ride and test the horse
- Expose horse to various environments/situations
- Evaluate suitability for intended purpose
- Assess behavior, soundness, and usability

Note: Board is covered under this fee

5. REQUIRED HEALTH CARE FOR HORSES COMING TO CONSULTANT'S FACILITY

For the safety of horses on the property, any horse entering Consultant's facility must receive:

- Parasite treatment
- Vaccinations (if not current)
- Worming (if not current)
- Current Health & Coggins
- Brand Inspection papers in order

These treatments are mandatory and will be completed at the owner's expense if proof of current care cannot be provided.

6. BOARDING FEES AFTER EVALUATION PERIOD

If the horse remains at Consultant's facility after the 30-day evaluation period, boarding fees will apply at:

\$15 per day

7. VETERINARY & FARRIER EXPENSES

All veterinary care, farrier work, emergency care, medications, supplements, and related expenses are the sole responsibility of the Client/Owner.

8. TRANSPORT TO PURCHASER

Transportation and delivery of the horse to the final purchaser is at the Purchaser's expense.

9. NO GUARANTEE

Consultant will make every reasonable effort to honestly assess and match horses appropriately; however, horses are animals and no guarantees are made regarding future behavior, soundness, performance, or suitability once the horse leaves Consultant's care.

10. LIABILITY

Client understands that equine activities involve inherent risks. Consultant shall not be held liable for injury, illness, loss, damages, or death involving any horse after purchase or transfer.

ADDITIONAL LIABILITY & PRE-PURCHASE EXAM TERMS

11. HORSE HEALTH, INJURY, OR DEATH

While every reasonable effort will be made to provide proper care and supervision, Client understands that horses are inherently unpredictable animals and that illness, injury, colic, accidents, or death may occur despite appropriate care.

In the event a horse becomes ill, injured, or dies from colic or any other uncontrollable or unforeseen circumstance while in the care of Wagoner Training LLC or Amber Wagoner, no liability shall be placed upon Wagoner Training LLC or Amber Wagoner.

Client assumes all risks associated with ownership and care of the horse and is financially responsible for any veterinary or emergency care expenses incurred while the horse is in Consultant's care.

EQUINE PURCHASE CONSULTING AGREEMENT

Consultant highly recommends that Client purchase equine mortality and major medical insurance coverage for any horse placed in Consultant's program or care.

12. PRE-PURCHASE EXAM (PPE)

Pre-Purchase Exams (PPEs) are not automatically included in consulting services.

A PPE will only be recommended or coordinated when:

- The horse is being purchased through a private treaty sale, AND
- The purchase price of the horse is \$10,000 or greater.

Any PPE costs, veterinary fees, radiographs, travel expenses, or related services shall be the sole responsibility of the Client/Purchaser.

13. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the full understanding between the parties and supersedes any prior verbal agreements.
